## **Get to Know OSU Quest**



Established: January 2010

Begin your Quest outside of Weatherford Hall at the corner of 26<sup>th</sup> Street and Jefferson Way. The Quest involves walking approximately half a mile on paved sidewalks outdoors as well as up and down stairs inside. ADA accessible routes are available in all building, but may require you to venture off course. Please remember to stay quiet when inside buildings as there are people working and studying. It generally takes about 45 minutes to complete.

Follow the directions and collect the clues to fill the numbered squares. At the end of your journey, the word will lead you to the hidden Quest Box. When you find the box, please sign the log book and let us know what you thought of this Quest. Just remember to put the box back in its hiding place for the next person to find. Enjoy!



Welcome to college! It's an exciting place to be. Here in Corvallis, At Oregon State University. The campus is big – 400 acres and counting. It's like a small city, 24,000 students and mounting!

Students at OSU Live, work, study, and play You'll see a few of all of these things On your Quest today.

In front of you is Weatherford Hall, Where students sleep, eat and study. Residence halls and dorms, Are great places to meet a new buddy.

Shaped like a W with a tall tower, It stands out from the rest.
There's a sauna, café and a TV lounge Many students like this the best.

The building honors a man
An alum and famous attorney.
Above the arch his full name reads
Put his middle initial in <u>clue square three</u>.

Make your way through the streetlamps 180 degrees from the tower's face Use the crosswalks to go North and East Up the stairs in the doors that beavers do grace.



This building is the Memorial Union Or the MU for short. It's got restaurants and couches, And a bowling alley for sport!

You can go take a peek downstairs There's even a massage chair! But then come back up Next to the place where they cut hair. It's hard not to notice
The giant statue of a beaver.
Made from one tall redwood tree,
This might turn you into a believer!

The mascot of Oregon State Is a beaver, NOT a duck or a hare. The second letter of his name Fits the **fifth clue square**.

Now, onward, through the glass doors Your tummy might rumble At the delicious-smelling food But try not to grumble!

Turn right at the burger joint And again up the main stairway To the hall of flags and the lounge Where students lay.

Each flag represents
An international student from that country
College is a great time to meet people
From all over the world, even Hungary.

Look for the flag that's red with a centered white cross (Hint: Go down the right corridor).



The first letter of the country's name Put in <u>clue square two</u> and no more.

## **QUESTIONS FOR THE CURIOUS: #1**

How many country's flags are represented in the Memorial Union?

The answer is in the Quest box at the end of your journey!

Now head to the map of campus Which lies near Room 109. You can see how big campus is – But look for the "You Are Here" sign.

The next stop will be #72
Head down the steps from where you came
Out to the grassy quad area —
It's green because of how much it rains!

The quad has events and sign-ups for clubs (There are over 300 of those). But head on the path that points to 10:00, There's no time to doze.

Look back at the MU It's quite impressive But then turn east on Campus Way To a building that's quite progressive.

Find Kelley Engineering Center on your left, It's so big, it's easy to see.

Go in the glass doors –

But pull hard – they're heavy!

This building has classrooms and labs For computer and electrical engineering It's also a "green" building Sustainability advocates are cheering!

Walk a few meters
Look to the left for the certification of gold
The second highest honor
In environmental design, so we're told.



The U.S. Green Building Council
Gives this award a name
The second of the four letters in the word
Is clue square seven in this game.

Proceed north to the atrium
And try to find what is "green"
Solar panels, natural light and using rainwater
Are all part of this structure's scene.

## **QUESTIONS FOR THE CURIOUS: #2**

What might be other environmentallyfriendly features of Kelley Engineering Center?

The answer is in the Quest box at the end of your journey!

Look up and around, At the art, computer labs, and café Then continue through the eastern door, On Memorial Place turn the south way.

Past the handicapped parking spaces
Of these, there are only a few
Most students bike, walk, or
skateboard,
Cars are difficult to get through!

Take a left at the grove of rhododendrons Then look before you cross Notice the color of the fire hydrant It's got a unique gloss.

The second letter of the color Belongs in <u>clue square six</u>
Wear this and black at OSU
And you'll fit into the mix.

Now you'll see a clock tower That plays the fight song at five And next to it, the library Our final spot to arrive! Head towards this building Of over 1 million books You'll need to know it's name For the next clue – take a look.

The second letter, a vowel, Belongs in <u>clue square one</u>, Then enter double doors You're almost done.

The circulation desk to your right Has employment for students Having a job to help pay for college Is sometimes quite prudent.

Next to this space Is a cow, patterned brightly. Find the artist's name on the wall, It says it, forthrightly.


The last name's first letter Is the final <u>clue square four</u>. Now use the clue to find the box You might need to explore...
