

# Parent Info & Financial Aid Forms

## Do I need to provide parent information on financial aid forms?

Most likely, as most students are considered dependents of their parents. Dependent students are required to include information for one or more parents on financial aid forms like the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Oregon Student Aid Application (ORSAA). Independent students do not need to include information for parents.

You may be an **INDEPENDENT STUDENT**.

You may not be required to provide parent information on your financial aid forms such as the FAFSA or ORSAA.

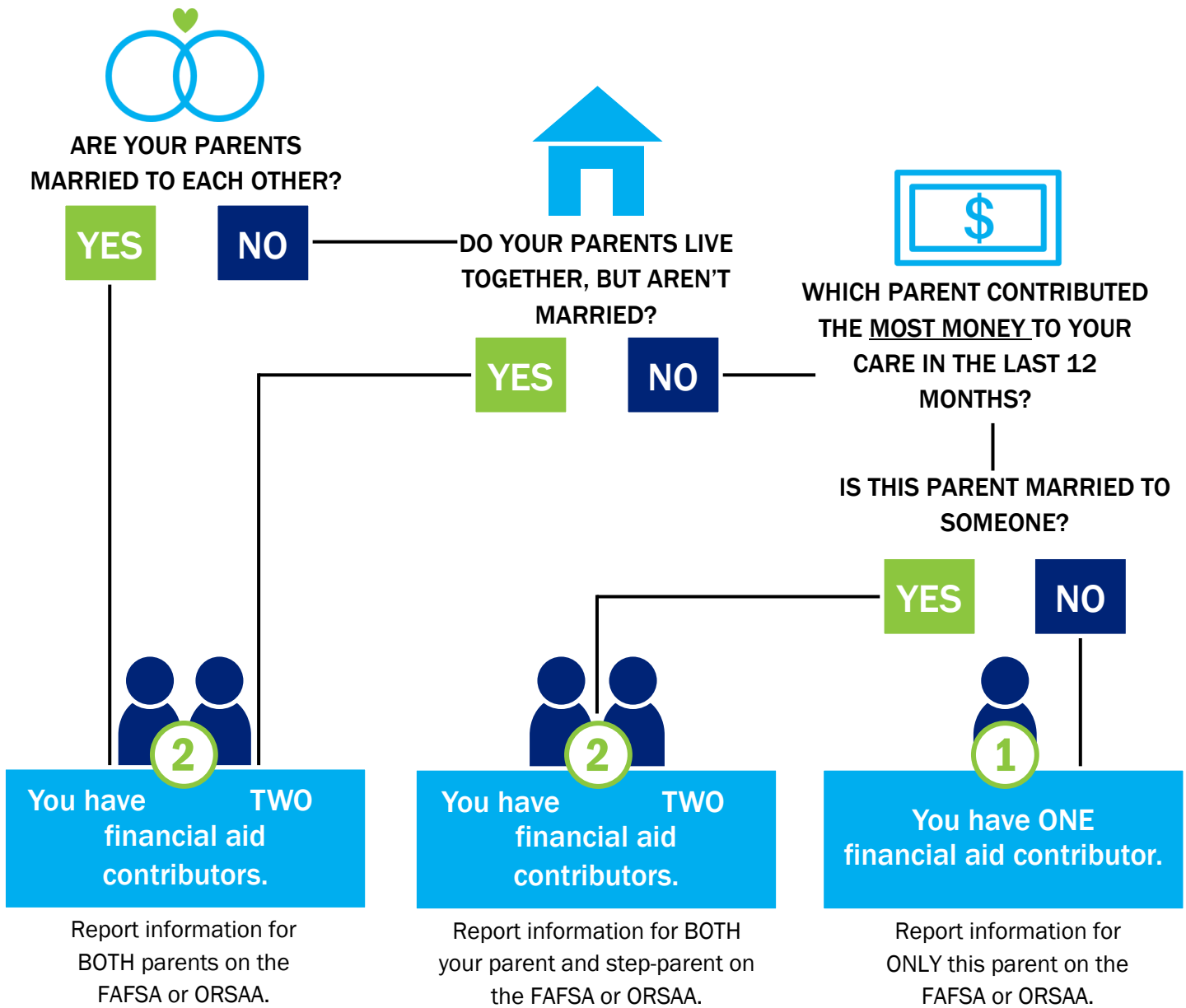


## What if...
