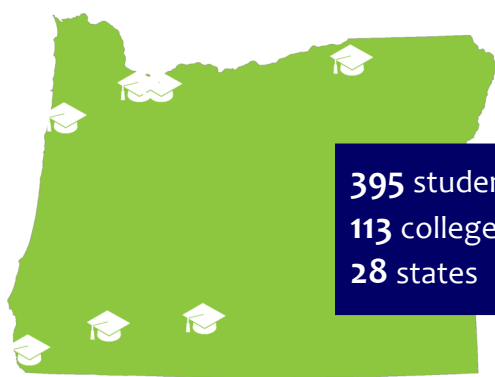

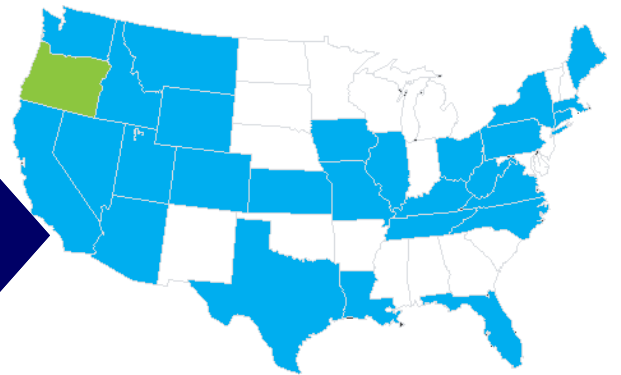
Students at 7 sites throughout Oregon participated in the state's inaugural College Application Week.

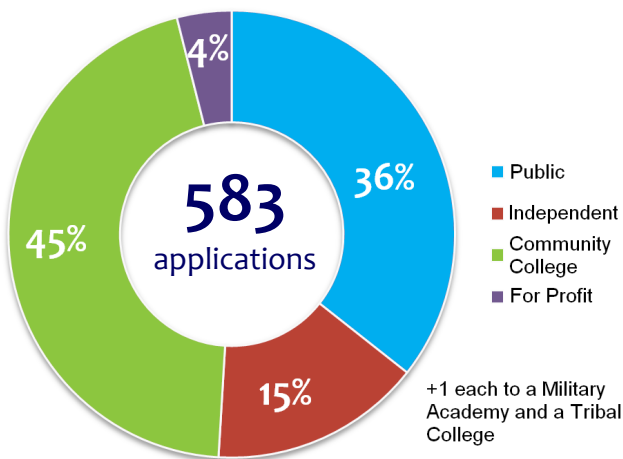


395 students applied to 113 colleges and universities in 28 states

On average, students submitted **1.48** applications to a wide variety of institutions.

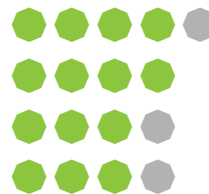

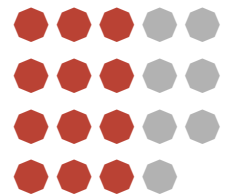
83% of the applications stayed in Oregon. They were submitted to
