WHY SHOULD OUR SCHOOL JOIN?

- Students who submit a completed financial aid form are more likely to enroll in postsecondary education.
- Participating schools benefit from access to:
 - your high school's FAFSA/ORSAA completion rate at 3 key dates throughout the challenge
 - free bilingual posters to encourage FAFSA/ORSAA completion and track your progress
 - monthly newsletters and technical assistance

You and your students will also benefit from being part of a statewide effort to increase the number of financial aid applications submitted by Oregon 12th graders by at least 5% during the 2019-20 school year. And when your school reaches your goal, you'll receive a certificate to celebrate your successes.

WHEN IS THE CHALLENGE?

Both the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the Oregon Student Aid Application (ORSAA) open on October 1st. FAFSAs and ORSAAs completed between October 1st and June 1st will count toward your school's Challenge goals.

WHAT DATA WILL WE GET?

You'll receive your school's combined FAFSA/ORSAA completion rates direct to your inbox.

Participating schools with 10 or more 12th graders on the official ODE census date (October 1st) will receive their FAFSA/ORSAA Completion rates for January 1st, March 1st, and June 1st.

Rates will be calculated as a percentage: the number of completed, no-error FAFSAs and ORSAAs received by OSAC on the specified date divided by the number of 12th graders enrolled at the high school on October 1st.



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
